Every ArtWalk event helps support [ArtReach San Diego](#), a nonprofit organization aimed at increasing equity in visual arts education to K-8 schools throughout San Diego County by delivering free or low cost workshops to schools that have no other resources for art.

ArtWalk @ Liberty Station will be held at Liberty Station's Ingram Plaza at 2751 Dewey Road, San Diego, CA 92106. The festival will run from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m. on Saturday, August 8, and 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. on Sunday, August 9. Attendance is free.
